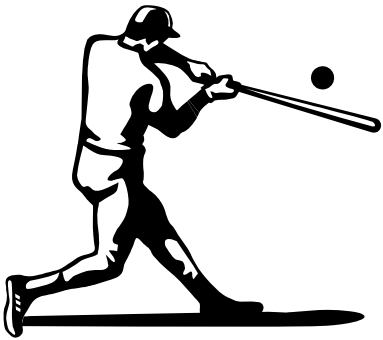


General Information

Registration will begin Monday at 7:30am at Jordan High School's Davis Field. Camp will run 8:30am to 12:00pm daily. Cost of the camp is **\$75.00 to be paid in full and is non-refundable. Payment can be made by cash or check. Checks must be written to Jordan Baseball Camp.** Once your application and payment has been received you will receive confirmation. Walk-ins on the day of registration will be accepted. Each camper must bring his/her own gear, bat, glove, cleats, sneakers (if raining), and catchers must bring equipment. Baseball pants are recommended. **In the case of rain each camper should bring sneakers to wear inside.**

Davis Field, softball field, 2 Full size batting cages, 1 football length practice field, and the JHS small gymnasium.



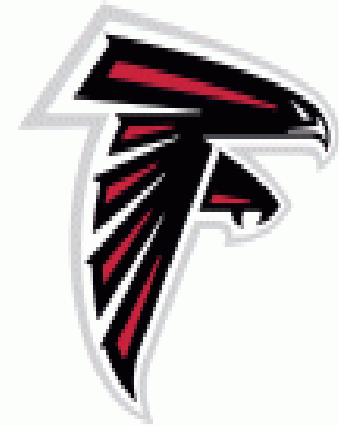
Directions

Head Coach:

Devy Bell

Coach Bell has been around the Jordan baseball program now for 22 years. He is a 1987 graduate from UNC at Chapel Hill. He played baseball and lettered all four years under Coach Mike Roberts. Coach Bell has led the Falcon's program since the 2003 season, winning the conference championship and coach of the year honors in 2007.

Assistant Coach/ Camp Director:

Coach Hall (92') was one of the first players coached by Davis and Bell. He is a graduate from both UNC at Greensboro and NCCU. Prior to Jordan, he was an assistant baseball coach at Orange High School where he was involved in both the High School and American Legion programs. Coach Hall is in his 8th season as an assistant coach and 7th year as camp director.

Head JV Coach:

Greg Pruitt

Coach Pruitt has been involved with the Jordan Baseball program since the early 1990's. Much of the structures in and around our baseball facility are a direct result of Coach Pruitt's contribution to the program. He has over 20 years of coaching high school players throughout the triangle area, and brings a wealth of knowledge to our program. In addition to coaching, Coach Pruitt has been a scout for both the Atlanta Braves and Kansas City Royals organizations. Coach Pruitt also often does individual skill instruction for all areas of the game.

Assistant Coach:

Andy Zeillman

Coach Zeillman played for the Falcons in the late 80's under Coach Popson. He has been coaching baseball and basketball in the Durham area for over 10 years. He was the JV baseball coach in 1999-2001 seasons. He now teaches Health/PE classes and is an assistant basketball and baseball coach at Jordan.
